Missionary Spotlight *by Bill Moon, Missions Committee*

Pastor Rei Abrudan, who is heading 4D Ministries in Romania, sends his yearly report on many aspects of his growing ministry with three main pillars of **equipping**, **resourcing** and **servicing** under the motto of "Because Spiritual Impact Matters."

Equipping:

For over 20 years we have been training leaders at different levels. Our observation is that training in Romania has become "information dissemination." To really train means to direct growth; to form by instruction, disciple or drill. So 4D's training is now interactive, cutting edge and practical. People reached: 769

Resourcing:

We get more and more requests for fresh and tested ideas. All the children and youth ministries that have started in the last 20 years are in need for specific resources. The demand for online resources is growing. Most of the leaders prefer to have access to a database to look for what they need instead of spending lots of money for books that might not suit them entirely. Resources include Media Safe Website, Lider Expres Website, Biserica Via Website, Biserica Via You Tube Channel, and Credo TV- television programs.

Servicing:

Our personal involvement with local churches in their children, youth and family outreaches builds our 4D credibility as ministry trainers. Activities are diverse and far reaching, ranging from discipleship groups to women's bible study groups, to teenage ministries, to international missions, to camps and retreats, to concerts, and to conferences, to name a few.
