This tradition has carried on today and has become the **National Day of Prayer**. I invite you to come to pray together at a special service at **7pm on Thursday May 3<sup>rd</sup>** at our Laguna Woods campus. Neighboring churches join us and it is a beautiful service of prayer, Bible readings and musical offerings. The theme for this year is "Pray for America - Unity." based upon Ephesian 4:3 **"Making every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."**

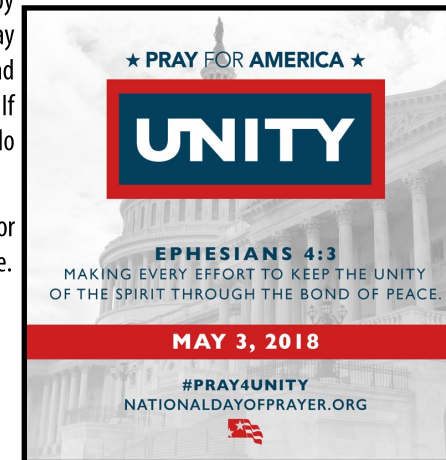
Dr. Ronnie Floyd, President of the National Day of Prayer, challenged a gathering of leaders from across the country, "What is God saying to our country right now?" "What is His heart for this nation?" He noted several signs of the times, including natural disasters, racial unrest, the worst mass murder in U.S. history, and "political division and polarization that has divided this nation beyond anything that any of us have ever seen in our generation." "We have to admit this: America is broken. Division is undeniable. Racial tension is alarming. Lawlessness abounds. Reconciliation appears impossible. Government cannot fix it. Politics will not heal it. And the spirit of the age is ruling all over this nation," Floyd said. But he noted that "the culture and its dark, hopeless condition is the perfect backdrop to call America to unity."

As believers, we are called to partner with God to make a difference wherever we are and to pray for those who are in high positions. (2 Timothy 2:1-2)

May prayer be a foundation for all our ministries, throughout our congregation, in our families and may we come together often to pray. Jesus is our example in all things. He taught us to pray by going to a quiet place to be away from the distractions of the grind of everyday hustle and bustle. If Jesus needed this... we surely do too!

Update from Lee and Fai Furney in Malawi:

We give thanks that we are able to have a plurality of church elders at Blantyre Community Church for the first time since our arrival. James Meiring, from the UK, was appointed on Sunday 18th March.

- Pray for James as he adjusts to this new responsibility and that we might be exporting rather than importing elders in years to come.

We are up and running with our new ministry training course on biblical exposition. We started with nine students from four different churches. Lee got out to the rural areas last week.

- Pray for the ageing pastors to be able to identify those who can be trained up to succeed them.

A recent course on 'Six Steps to Talking About Jesus' has been a help to encourage and equip the church in our mission to make disciples. There are some promising signs that we are starting to develop a culture of evangelism.
