Dear Friends in Christ,

"We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all." (Isaiah 53:6)

One of God's favorite metaphors in the Bible is that of a shepherd. All throughout Scripture, the importance of leading the flock comes shining through. Abel kept flocks. Abraham had large herds of sheep and goats. Moses and David were shepherds who predicted a time when a great Shepherd would emerge. Jesus claims His mission to seek and save the lost sheep (Luke 19:10) and reach out and claim the sheep that are not of this pen (John 10:16). Jesus refers to Himself as the *Good Shepherd* and we have Him depicted as such in the beautiful stained glass window inside our Laguna Woods sanctuary.



The Bible reveals in John's apocalypse that God's people are to be finally guided into a fold of rest: *"The sun will not beat upon them, nor any scorching heat. For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; He will lead them to springs of living water. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes"* (Rev. 7:15-17). Clearly, God loves the idea of a good shepherd and a good flock.

As a pastor and perhaps because I grew up on the farm, I see my role as a shepherd: to **feed, lead and protect**. In Acts 20:28-31 Paul said, *Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock. Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to draw away disciples after them. So be on your guard! Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears.*

I feel it is my duty as your shepherd to make sure you are **fed**. Spiritual food is feeding on God's Word. We have many wonderful opportunities to study God's Word together. I encourage you to jump in any time along the way. I guarantee you will learn, know and grow in His Word. I also feel compelled to **lead** you to the quiet life-giving waters of a life lived in Christ. I care deeply about you as children of God and I want you to have the blessed assurance that your life is safe

Good Shepherd. I also want to **protect** and encourage you from drifting away from your faith. So many people find many other things in life that become more important than a relationship with Christ. I wish for you to think about how much Jesus loves you. He laid down His life for yours... why? Because He loves you.

Jesus is your loving Shepherd. As the author of Hebrews says, *"let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water."* ²³Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:22-25)

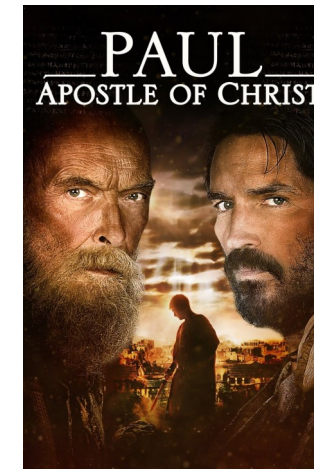


October Events - Join Us!
