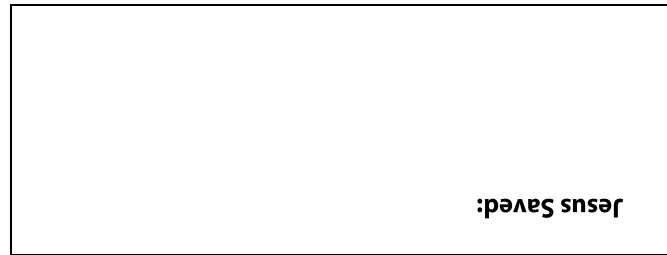

As we have just given thanks to our Lord for the many blessings in our lives during this Thanksgiving season, let it not stop there. Paul says, *Rejoice in the Lord always. Missionary Spotlight by Tracey Awwad, Missions Committee

Denise Carlson, serving in Africa, is a missionary we've been helping to support in the last few years. Many of you may remember meeting her as she's been to LCC several times. Denise works amidst the refugee camps on the border of South Sudan and Uganda where over a million people live. She reports that murders, rapes, beatings, kidnappings, and child trafficking occur in this area; moreover, infectious diseases such as cholera, typhoid, and ebola exact a further traumatic toll.

Such dire circumstances notwithstanding, God is sovereign and Denise's ministry is part of the 'hands and feet' of Christ in the area. Over the past months, 10 churches have been built, food distribution has reached hundreds of Refugee churches in 9 camps, along with Bible and shoe distributions. Especially praiseworthy is that the churches are growing and the ministry has held six conferences to equip servant leaders. Please continue to lift Denise and this ministry up in prayer—that God would call and touch many more to Him through Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.
