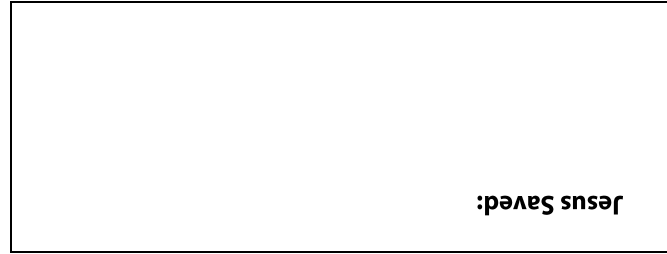

FOUNDATION FOR HIS MINISTRY

Our partnership with the Foundation for His Ministry (FFHM) has blessed the lives of many children and individuals in Mexico. Through your generosity and faithful support, FFHM saw God's faithfulness demonstrated through the many volunteers, donors and staff who serve in His Ministry. A few highlights include:

- A new daycare established to serve over 100 children whose parents work in the fields in and around San Quintin, about 1/2 hour south of the Baja mission.
- Eight students from the Tijuana House graduated from the University and Technical School in Tijuana.
- Outreach teams ministered in work camps in Sinaloa home to over 250,000 displaced people working in the fields.
- Eight missionaries and teams from the Bible Institute ministered to unreached peoples in the mountains of Oaxaca.

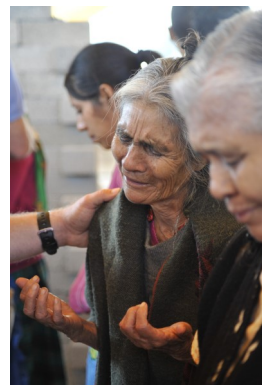

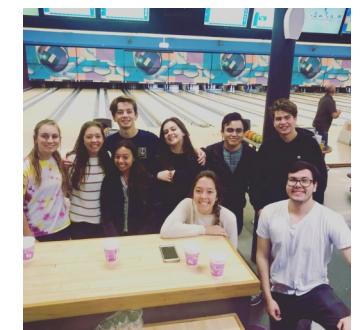
