## Remembering the Cross

Blessings in Christ everyone,  
May the Lord continue to guide us each day as we remember what Christ has done for us! During Lent, we focus on remembering the cost of our salvation. A large cross is brought in to our Laguna Woods sanctuary, and at our Aliso Viejo sanctuary we already have a very large wooden cross that we focus on every time we enter. These crosses represent the cross where Jesus died. A place where

our sins intersect with His holiness and righteousness. A place where God allowed His perfect Son to die for every wrong thing we have done, said, thought or left undone. On the cross, Jesus finished the work that was required to save us from the death we deserve. Romans 6:23 reminds us... *"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."*

Seeing the cross causes us to consider what Jesus endured for us. Before being crucified, Jesus was flogged and spit on. The soldiers hit Him in the head with sticks and made Him carry His own cross to the place where He would die, but He was too weak from the brutal flogging. At Golgotha, they hammered nails through His flesh to keep Him on the cross when they turned it upright. Those wounds bore the weight of His body as He hung there. Six hours later, Jesus took His final breath (Mark 15:37). A centurion who witnessed Jesus's death declared, *"Surely this man was the Son of God!"* (v. 39).

For all of us at Lutheran Church of the Cross, as we go through this season of Lent, may we consider what the cross means to us. Jesus suffered and died there and then rose again to make eternal life possible. Because of Jesus' death and resurrection, we all have a new life in Jesus Christ. *"Everyone who belongs to Christ will be given new life."* 1 Corinthians 15:22. That New Life in Christ means we have a new beginning filled with His grace every day.

As we all go through this life, which can easily be filled with times of trouble and problems, let us keep our focus on the cross which is the ultimate love Christ shows to each of us. May we remember Isaiah 41:13 paints a beautiful word picture for us: *"For I am the LORD your God who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you."* That help is Jesus Christ. May you find Christ as your encouragement for yourself and others as we go through Lent and the rest of our lives.

Rei has been in ministry for more than 25 years in this former Soviet-controlled country and has been instrumental in pioneering youth and student ministry after the Iron Curtain collapse.

Since 2015, Rei has been the leader of a new church in Cluj, Romania. It grew to over 200 members in a year with an additional 200+ who are able to access services via regional TV.

Endeavors in 2019 are to deepen and grow the youth ministry (AerCurat) and the ministry for the young professionals (FLUX). Each month invited speakers teach and inspire discussion on pertinent topics for their season of life. Recent sessions include a Christian therapist talking about happiness, a leading filmmaker & playwright who talked about art and the Christian life. 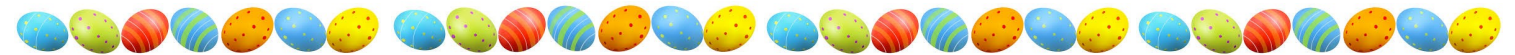
