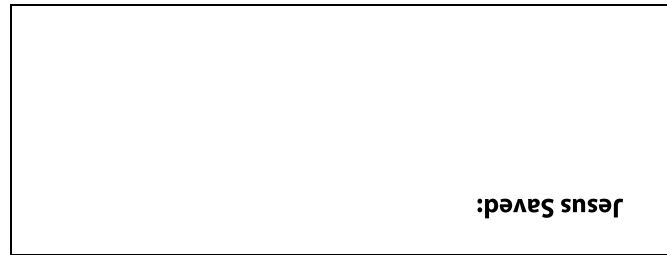

Lutheran Church of the Cross will host the National Day of Prayer ecumenical service on Thursday, May 2, at 7pm at our Laguna Woods campus. The theme this year is "Love One Another" which comes from the words of Jesus in John 13:34, "Love one another. Just as I have loved you." What a beautiful theme for this year and throughout the year. Please come to this service and invite your friends, relatives, associates and neighbors to come pray with us.

Love is the message of the Gospel. "For God so loved the world that He gave His One and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him." John 3:16-17

The National Day of Prayer was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, President Ronald Reagan signed the amended law designating the first Thursday of May as a day of National Prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation.

"There is no great movement of God that has ever occurred that does not begin with the extraordinary prayer of God's people," Dr. Ronnie Floyd, President of the National Day of Prayer Task Force.

And speaking of reaching out to love one another, Paul wrote to the Colossians... "Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful." Colossians 3:14-15

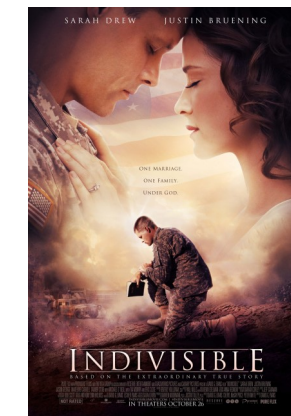


Worship, Dinner & a Movie at LW

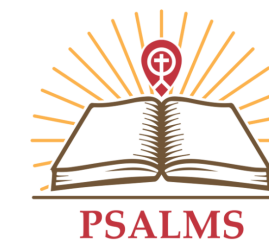
85 and Better Luncheon

Missions Update: The ROBISON Family in Japan
 Many in our church family may recall Dave Robison speaking to our congregation last Fall. Dave, his wife Tomo, and their three young children have since returned to Japan to prepare for a new church plant. The Robisons serve in an area that was hit by a major earthquake and tsunami 8 years ago. They report:

"The scars from the tsunami are visible throughout the town, but in people's hearts they are largely hidden.

Most struggle quietly on their own, still dealing with feelings of grief and loss. But it's in the midst of this grief that our church has been able to reach out and build loving relationships with survivors. Often we bring the kids along which the older residents seem to really enjoy. They all seem to have children and grandchildren who live far away and don't get to see often enough".

Their prayer requests: for God's love to be felt as they minister in this community; for opportunities to steer conversations toward deeper spiritual needs, that the Gospel may be shared and understood; the cafe ministries to bear fruit in leading people to Christ; that God would add believers to their worship gatherings, and for the new church plant to take root.
