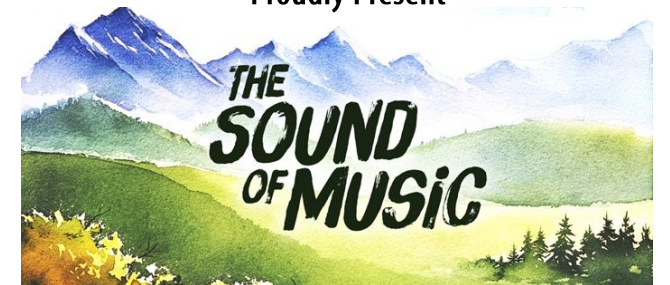

**Missionary Spotlight** by Tracey Awwad, Missions Committee

**Go Missions International** is preparing for its ten year anniversary as an official organization. In 2009, while working at the Christian Training Center in Caranavi, Bolivia, Nick and Shannon Kraft took a group of students up river where they stopped in twelve villages and did creative evangelism. Impacted by the needs so close to home, the graduated students began a prayer meeting in the city of La Paz, asking the Lord what more they could do... the Lord responded with what is now their Mantra Sobre Todo AMAR SERVIR (Above All Love and Serve). The simple theme of Love and Serve has been motivating this small mission society for the last ten years. The Kraft family was soon dispatched to Peru where they have built a Christian Training and Healing Center called the House of the Potter. This retreat-like setting is home to THE CORE, (discipleship in missions), VIVE woman's retreat for self-care and inner healing, and IMMERSE, an immersion camp in English. It also serves as a home for students from the Amazon who are studying in the city.



**The Kraft Family**

*Go Missions* continues to be on the Go reaching out to a tribe called the Wambis. They are a people group who are slowly being reached for Christ. They speak Wambis and have remained somewhat isolated from the mainstream society. However, in recent years their youth have been seeking education and coming out of the jungle and into the city where they are faced with all kinds of temptation. They are vulnerable and often feel very alone. *Go Missions International* is slowly building a relationship with them. So far, we have had eight students attend CORE, and now two students are with us here in Chiclayo studying.

*Go Mission Bolivia* continues to thrive as well. They meet weekly for prayer with over 45 college students and young adults in La Paz and Caranavi. They reach out weekly to villages on the edge of the city who have no evangelical influence. They also plan and execute children's camps, mission mobilization in the churches, and service projects around the city. Each year they plan and raise money for one missions trip. This year's trip will be to Peru, for the Anniversary Celebration.

Can you pray for us?

- In Peru, with the growth of our staff, we need to build two dorm rooms and more bathrooms.
- Please pray for our involvement in the Wambis tribe that we can be a positive experience with Christ.
- For *Go Missions Bolivia* to continue to THRIVE and that the Lord will be faithful to continue sending them out.
