SAFETY UPDATE by Kevin Murphy, Director of Operations

Blessings to all and I hope everyone is enjoying their summer. This has been a busy summer for Lutheran Church of the Cross and Aliso Viejo Christian School. As you know, we made SAFETY a top priority for both campuses and set the strategy in place to implement a number of safety measures in Laguna Woods and Aliso Viejo. Let me begin by thanking all the generous donors from the Aliso Viejo Christian School GALA fundraiser last year. We raised approximately \$80K from that event alone. Also, a big thank you to a bequest that was given to the church that allowed us to match the amount achieved from the GALA event.

The safety projects were completed at Aliso Viejo where the school currently has 335 students in attendance; These projects are:

- ◆ Perimeter fencing around the entire school. This was needed to keep potential intruders out and to keep our kids, parents and staff safe. The six foot fencing encompasses all the buildings.
- ◆ Key fob entry for main entrances. This is very important as the school needs to know who enters the campus and what their stated business is at all times. These fobs are on all the main entrances with only employees having access to enter the buildings.

- ◆ Intercoms at the main entrance and child care pickup locations. Intercoms are located at the main entrance of the building where staff can see who is approaching and there stated business. In addition, our after school childcare is set up the same way in another building where parents have to identify themselves to be able to pick their children up at the end of the school day.
- ◆ Patio structure in front of Aliso Viejo campus. This structure was put together for two reasons. First, to provide safety from all angles of the front entrance to keep a potential driver from running into the buildings. Bollards were installed at potential entry points and the retaining wall was built with protective steel in it to keep a vehicle from entering the building. Second, the new patio is a nice place for school attendees and church families to gather, relax and have fellowship with others before school or church.

At the Laguna Woods campus, we are installing fences in two areas between the church and offices and between the church and nursery area. The church has had issues with the homeless and vandalism and this fencing will keep out any intruders after hours.

We are considering installing security cameras at both LW and AV. We have interviewed several vendors and are in the process of finalizing deals for both locations.

Please pray for all the churches and schools around the world that have been victims of senseless acts of violence. Let's continue to be vigilant and keep our eyes and ears open at all times for potential issues on our campuses.

I leave you with this verse from Psalms 4:8: "In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, Lord, make me dwell in safety."
