Dear Reverend Lantz,

I am writing to express my appreciation for the gift sent to Samaritan's Purse from Lutheran Church of the Cross for hurricane relief. Your partnership in this ministry means so much.

Recently I was in the Bahamas where we have over 100 staff on the ground responding to the devastation left behind by Hurricane Dorian. Our Disaster Assistance Relief Team is distributing tons of shelter plastic, water filtration units, and other emergency supplies to storm victims. Our medical team at the Samaritan's Purse Emergency Field Hospital in Freeport has already provided medical care to over 2,500 people. There is incredible destruction—it will take these people a long time to recover and rebuild. Our teams have also been responding on Ocracoke Island, North Carolina, as many homes were flooded during the hurricane.

Please pray for those whose lives have been turned upside down and for our teams as we help in Jesus' Name. We want people to know that they can put their trust in the Lord, who is "*a refuge for the needy in their distress, a shelter from the storm*" (Isaiah 25:4a). May God bless you.

LCC has been supporting Susy Harbick in Nigeria for several years. Susy's ministry is in working with children through Rafiki Village Nigeria. A number of children in the village have moved on to higher education now. Three are preparing to graduate from University, 13 are currently enrolled and another 18 will begin. Praise for God's hand of blessing and provision for these young people.

As a result of these transitions, some of the resident cottages are being remodeled into classrooms to serve young children--two rooms for 3-4 year-olds and another for 18 kindergarteners. In 2020, 108 children under age six will be served. Please pray for this ministry to thrive and for God's favor to be upon Susy's work.
