Dear friends in Christ, **"Come, Lord Jesus!"**

Growing up back on a farm in Stanton, Iowa, we would say a very common prayer before meals, **"Come, Lord Jesus!"** Perhaps you've said it too – **"Come, Lord Jesus, be our guest. Let these gifts to us be blessed, Amen.** I remember saying it as fast as possible because I was hungry! Perhaps we should slow down and think about the words, **"Come, Lord Jesus"** and what they mean to us.

We are entering into the season of Advent. The word "advent" comes from the Latin *"adventus"* which literally means the "coming" or the "arrival" of someone or something. After John saw the vision of what is to come and how amazing it was, he ended the entire Bible with this prayer: **"Come, Lord Jesus"** (Revelation 22:20).

Advent reminds us that salvation doesn't depend on us going to Christ, but Christ comes to us. He comes, He came, and He will come again, **to us and for us.** He has chosen us and He chooses us again and again, God's mercy and forgiveness incarnate.

John 14:1-6 is often chosen to be read at memorial services. . . *"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. ²My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. ⁴You know the way to the place where I am going."* ⁵Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?" ⁶Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

During this Advent season, slow down, ponder the words. . . **Come Lord Jesus.** Participate in the activities we have planned and read the special advent devotional. Invite neighbors and friends to join with you and then let us all pray with certain hope and full confidence that God's will is clearly **for us:** **"Come, Lord Jesus, come. Amen."** Contemplate how your life is filled with hope because Christ has come for you!
