40 Days of Lent

Dear Friends in Christ,

This year on March 1 the next season in our church year will begin. Some call it the Passion of the Christ season. We also call it the season of Lent; not because we aren't passionate about our faith or because we don't want to think about Jesus' passion for us. Rather, it is a time of preparation and a time of reflection. It's a repentant time where the cross of Christ speaks to us anew. Lent comes from an Anglo Saxon word for "Spring" and is related to our English word "lengthen." It refers to that penitential period before Easter. Lent has been observed by Christians for hundreds of years. It was initially part of a pre-baptismal preparation period that over time morphed into a 40 day period of devotion in advance of Easter – based on the 40 days that Jesus fasted in the desert (Mark 1:13). Jesus knew that "Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). In fact, some Christians today still fast or "give up something for Lent" as a way of reminding themselves that we depend on God alone and draw all our strength and resources from Him. The season of Lent begins this year on March 1, Ash Wednesday: a day when we place ashes on our foreheads in the shape of the cross. It's a stark image that tells us once again that Jesus took to the cross our mortal failings – our certain return to the dust with which we were made. There he exchanged that fatal future for the certainty of eternal life through His own suffering, death and resurrection. Thanks be to God! So do we have to fast or give up something for Lent? Of course not. We can certainly do that, but we don't have to give up something - Jesus already did that for us! We are forever marked with the grace of that glorious cross of Jesus. But perhaps during this season of Lent, we can still fast in a different way. Perhaps through

the reflection of that same cross he has placed on us, we can see our lives through Jesus. Perhaps we can let Jesus prepare us, not necessarily through a fast from food, but through a fast that better reflects Him and a feast that points us to the certain celebration of Easter. Perhaps this Lenten season we can take a fast from criticism and feast on praise; take a fast from self-pity and feast on joy; take a fast from a quick temper and feast on peace; take a fast from selfishness and feast on service; take a fast from fear and feast on faith. That's what the power of the cross enables us to do - to spend the season of Lent seeing Jesus prepare us - for Himself!
