

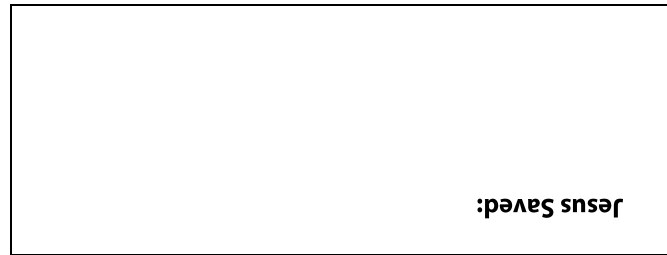

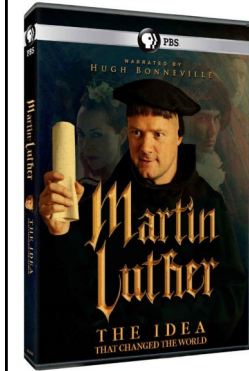

## The Reformation and a New Luther Movie

Was the Reformation really that big of a deal? YES!!!! The Reformation was no doubt a very big deal for our continuing walk in faith as Lutherans and our understanding of Scripture, of grace alone and faith alone through Christ alone that we study and preach and live out every day. But, Luther's life and works also set the stage for changes in culture, economics, and politics that still reverberate today. Anti-authoritarianism, capitalism, anti-slavery movements, women's suffrage and the civil rights movement in the centuries that followed also trace their roots to the Reformation. In fact, without Luther's protest, there would have been no pilgrims, no Puritans and no America in the way we know it! Hmm. A small, simple protest against indulgences by a nobody German monk (miraculously!) turned the world around! It was quite a big deal! This year a brand-new movie was made that looks deeply into the origin of Luther and his ideas. It is aptly titled: **"Martin Luther: The Idea that Changed the World."** Funded by Thrivent Financial, the film dramatizes the events that shaped Luther and examines the key questions he wrestled with, such as "Who am I," "What is my purpose?" and "How do I get right with God?" **We are privileged to have a special congregational viewing of this film after it becomes available from PBS in late November; details are forthcoming.**

## Missionary Spotlight by Geri Robinson, Missions Committee

Our church has been sponsoring the Robisons for several years. Dave hails locally from San Juan Capistrano; he was homeschooled by his mom and his dad is a pastor. He and Tomo met while Dave was on a missionary trip to Japan (she is also the daughter of a pastor there). They married in 2009 and are now the parents of three young children; Silas, their youngest, was born just a few months ago.

Dave's last update was very uplifting regarding how God has been working: "God has been working in so many ways this summer, it's hard to wrap our minds around all of it! Our church has done more outreach in this last month than any other that I can remember since we've been attending. We have ten people who are preparing to become members of our church. Two people are preparing to be baptized, one of whom just became a Christian last month. Our church is also considering overseeing a church plant in the coastal city of Miyako and has encouraged us to join the church planting team. We're teaching English to about a dozen adults and a half dozen kids. At the end of last month we hosted a Summer Festival which had our biggest turn out yet in terms of people attending from outside the church. And our English Cafe has been welcoming more and more people each month. It's been an exhausting period of ministry, but at the same time, the most exciting one since we've been here! We're praising God for all the new people He's brought us into contact with, and praying for opportunities and wisdom in how to follow up with all of them."
