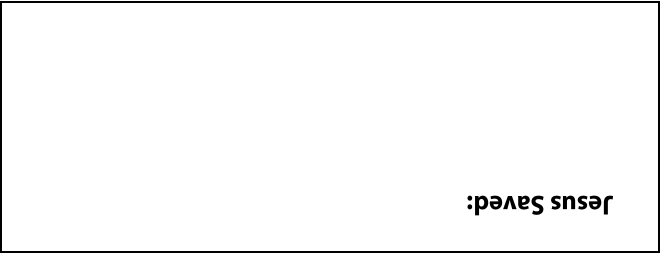

Dear family in Christ,
"I am crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. I do not set aside the grace of god, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!" Galatians 2:20-21

I love the season of Lent as I am reminded of the journey Christ made for me by taking my sins upon Himself to the cross. For me, it is a time to reflect and refocus my life on His calling for me. In John 10:10, Jesus said, *"I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."* In Galatians 2:20, Paul is telling us Christ is the center of his life for "Christ lives in him" and the *purpose* of his life is to live it "crucified with Christ."

What does it mean for us to live crucified with Christ? With Christ at the center of our lives, we have a new identity. 2 Cor. 5:17 Paul says, *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!"* Knowing our position in Christ solves all *identity* issues. Just like all kinds of identity theft happening in the world today, the devil wants to steal our identity...But in Christ our identity is sealed forever!

As we re-center our lives in Christ, He gives us strength and purpose to live each day for Him. Phil 4:13 *"I can do everything through Him who gives me strength."* Every day we have can live in a relationship with Him because we are given eternal life (John 3:16). *"If we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. So whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord."* (Romans 14:8) Finally, if Christ is the center of our life, we can accept the world as a place we can live in without fear. 1 John 4:4 says, *"You dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world."*

The question I would like you to ponder during this season of Lent is, **"Who is Jesus to you?"** During Lent, we will have midweek Lenten services held at the LW campus. We will hear monologues presented by people from our congregation during the Lenten services. Join us for this meaningful time of worship.

I hope and pray you will also center your life in Christ... not just during Lent, but every day of your life.

Missions Update: Daniel & Sharon Okabe, Faith Radio Uganda

Since our last update a year ago, Daniel and Sharon have welcomed a new addition to their family - a daughter, Kimberly, who is now about 6 months old. Sharon suffered from malaria while pregnant, but praise be to God for safeguarding them and the family is doing well.

Their ministry is a special call as radio is the primary source of news for the typical Ugandan and this is the vehicle by which the gospel goes out. The radio audience is a young one as the average age in Uganda is 15.5 and the life expectancy is only about 53. This is due to the impact of HIV/AIDS and many orphaned children. Through 2019, millions were reached with the gospel through this work; Faith Radio's audience was increased by 15%.

This work, however, is not without significant challenges. There have been major floods that have hit the area where the Okabes live and malaria continues to be a common affliction. Yet God remains Sustainer and Protector of their well-being, ministry, and those they serve. The generosity of special gifts received from many of their sponsors during this period evidenced God's hand of provision. Please pray that many lives would be transformed through their programming at Faith Radio, that their marketing efforts be blessed by entering large commercial markets for advertising, and that there would be provision of computers, software, and accessories so that the work can be enhanced. Continue to pray for the Okabes - for health, strength, and blessing.


